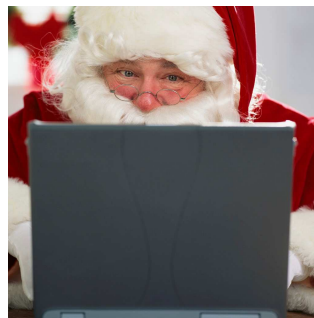

Farewell

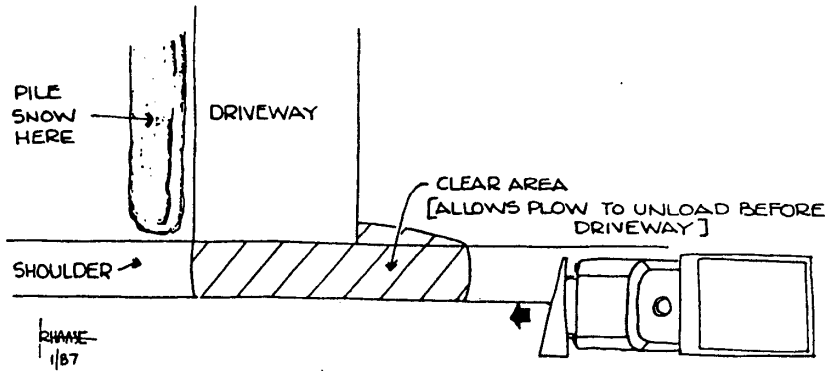

Snow Removal

- Wait until the trucks are finished plowing to shovel your driveway.
- As you are standing in your driveway facing the street, shovel the snow to the right of your driveway, to avoid getting "plowed in" on the next pass.
- Park off the street whenever snow is in the forecast. This is encouraged in the Towne Court development (park on the sidewalks). When plows have to negotiate around parked cars, it takes us longer to plow, and snow will get packed tightly around your car, making shoveling more difficult for you.
- Move basketball nets far back away from the street and curb. Nets that hang out past the curb are still in the way of the tall plow trucks.
- Please remember to clear your own sidewalks of snow and ice. Many people walk along the sidewalks in the Borough to go to the bus stop, or for exercise. Please keep them clear for your community neighbors.
- Plow operators are doing a difficult job under adverse conditions. Please do your part to make their job easier, and to get the streets cleared faster.



Mail Delivery

Borough Council has instructed the Borough Staff to look into the issue of mail delivery in the Borough. A committee is currently being formed to pursue any options available and decide how the Borough citizens would like to proceed.
